Popular attractions include Pangong Lake, Nubra Valley, Tso Moriri Lake, Magnetic Hill, and monasteries like Hemis, Thiksey, and Diskit. Adventure lovers flock here for road trips via Khardung La and Chang La, two of the highest motorable passes in the world. The ideal time to visit is May to September, when roads from Manali and Srinagar remain open and the weather is pleasant. With its unique terrain, clear skies, and rich Tibetan-influenced culture, Leh-Ladakh promises an unforgettable experience for bikers, backpackers, families, and photography enthusiasts alike.

Day 1: Delhi To Manali




- Departure from Delhi Around 10:00 pm
- Overnight journey to Manali.
- Distance: ~530 km | Travel Time: 12–14 hours

Day O2: Check in Manali hotel & Manali local sightseeing.



- Check-in to hotel and freshen up
- Visit Hadimba Temple, Club House, Tibetan Monastery, Mall Road
- Dinner & overnight stay in Manali

Day O3: Manali to Sarchu Via Atal Tunnel - Keylong - Jispa - Darcha - Baralacha La.



- Cross Atal Tunnel, stop at Keylong, Jispa, Darcha
- Visit Suraj Tal & cross Baralacha La (16,040 ft)
- Reach Sarchu, dinner & overnight in camps/hotel


Day 04: Sarchu to Leh via Nakee La, Lachung La, Gata Loops & Tanglang La.



- Drive through Gata Loops (21 bends), Nakee La, Lachung La
- Cross Tanglang La (17,480 ft) 2nd highest motorable road
- Arrive in Leh by evening, rest at hotel



Day 05: Leh local sightseeing



- Visit Leh Palace, Shanti Stupa, Leh Market
- Explore Sangam Point, Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, Magnetic Hill, Hall of Fame
- Return to hotel, dinner & overnight stay

Day 06: Leh to Nubra Valley via Kardung La pass.



- Drive to Nubra via Khardung La (18,380 ft)
- Visit Diskit Monastery, enjoy Hunder Sand Dunes (camel ride optional)
- Dinner & overnight stay in Nubra





Day 07: Nubra to Pangong Lake via Shyok River.



- Scenic drive along Shyok River route
- Reach Pangong Tso (14,270 ft) India's most iconic lake
- Dinner & overnight stay at Pangong (camp/hotel)

Day 08: Pangong to Leh via Changla Pass, Shey, Thikshey & Rancho School.



- Early morning view of Pangong
- Return via Chang La (17,586 ft)
- Visit Shey Palace, Thiksey Monastery, Rancho School
- Reach Leh by evening, dinner & night stay




Day 09: Leh to Jispa
